Metropolis delegation in city

Hyderabad: Amidst prevailing uncertainty in the city, a four-member Metropolis delegation from Paris met the Municipal Administration and Urban Development (MA&UD) department officials on Tuesday to ascertain whether the Metropolis World Congress will be held as scheduled in Hyderabad October next year.

Joshi, Adhar Sinha and GHMC commissioner M T Krishna Babu to review the arrangements for the Metropolis World Congress, scheduled to be held from October 6 to 10, 2014. About 2,000 representatives from various parts of the world are expected to participate in the meet.

MA&UD department principal secretary S K Joshi said it would be a good opportunity for Hyderabad to project itself as an international city as delegates from New

York, Tokyo, Seoul and other major city mayors and city government representatives would be visiting the city. He further stated that the main aim of the meeting was to discuss projects to be taken up, exchange of views and arrangements to be made for the conference, including venue.

The delegates along with the commissioner called on mayor Mohd Majid Hussain to discuss arrangements being made for the Metropolis. Mayor assured the delegation that every possible help would be provided for the meeting. He directed the officials to coordinate with the delegation and put up proposals for developmental works before the standing committee.
